B7 is a vibrant, cheeky, active young boy, who loves running, football, imaginative play, trampolining, nerf guns, trucks and Minecraft!

B7 has a diagnosis of Autism, Pathological Demand Avoidance (PDA) PANDAS and Sensory Processing Disorder (SPD). At times, often through frustration, B7 may display challenging behaviours. This wonderful family are supporting B7 to manage his outbursts, better understand his triggers and help him to regulate his emotions. Encouraging positive behaviour and using positive language is key whilst also giving B7 suitable options where possible. We are looking for a calm, kind, yet engaging Sennie, who has ASD experience and understands the importance of language towards a child with PDA.

### **About G11 and G15**

Both girls are delightful, creative, love arts/crafts, music and animals.

G11 Has a diagnosis of ADHD and ASD and needs some help with self organisation and lots of love as she sometimes feels left out due to B7 needing a lot of attention). G15 is really interested in art, enjoys playing the drums.

We are looking for a Super weekend Sennie who is ready to fully embrace a very charming but highly demanding little 7 year old boy, who is in need of a very empathic, creative and driven approach. B7 is currently homeschooled and we are looking for a Sennie who is comfortable with providing educational support as well as creative play.
