About the role:

The boys usually have a Sennie each during the holidays, although there are some aspects of the job that are 1:2 including but not limited to meal prep, meal time and mornings before the second Sennie arrives. The selected Sennie will have the opportunity to double up with existing team members for as long as needed, to ensure they feel confident in their new role & prior to taking either of the boys out alone. The family are very hands-on, and can provide additional training and support for the right candidate. **They are available to train their new Sennie from the Easter School Holidays 2021 (a covid lateral flow test prior to starting may be required)**

This wonderful family has a great track record of Nannies staying long term. They have created a happy, respectful work environment for all the team involved. , making them fantastic employers. Their current carers have been with them for 2-6 years, and they are looking for a team player, who understands the importance of consistency and collaboration.
